

# Sample Framework for Church Reopening Risk Assessment

- Understand government guidelines regarding COVID-19
- Understand BUC and Mission or Conference guidelines
- Communicate with all church members
- Confirm arrangements for church members, family members, and officer risk assessments
- Put appropriate PPE in place
- Assess facilities & processes to reduce transmission
- Have adequate staff for services
- Have adequate space for social distancing
- Give enough notice for services
- Arrange worship activities in line with infection prevention and control
- Keep an accurate register of attendance
- Have a clear policy & standard operating procedures for the key worship activities
- Provide alternative online arrangements



- Carry out individual church member risk assessments
- Consider transportation to church & appropriate PPE
- Give training in PPE and social distancing
- Obtain appropriate PPE
- Be aware of symptoms, history and the need to self isolate
- Assess ability to manage own hand & respiratory hygiene

- Confirm that individual church member risk assessments have been carried out
- Carry out staff risk assessments
- Train staff on social distancing
- Train staff in the use of PPE
- Train staff on health and safety protocol

- Confirm that individual church member risk assessments have been carried out
- Confirm arrangements for travel to church and appropriate PPE availability and use
- Train families on PPE & social distancing
- Train families in awareness of symptoms, medical history and need to self-isolate
- Assess ability to manage own hand & respiratory hygiene
- Consider needs of multigenerational families and identify high risk family members
